

INFORMATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF UE REG. N. 679/2016 ("GDPR")

This policy indicates which of your personal data are collected by **Filmmaster Events S.r.l.**, for which purpose and the manner in which they are processed. Hereafter, you will find the information necessary for exercising your rights according to GDPR.

Generally, we collect your data from the website <http://mobilitymakers.primespot.it/> (hereafter known as '**Website**'), anytime you send us e-mails or when we answer your questions. We inform you that the personal data collected during these processes will be processed so that we may respond to your requests, and in order to allow you to benefit from the services offered by the Website, as detailed below.

1. Who processes your data: data controller

Filmmaster Events S.r.l., with registered headquarters in Piazza Venezia 11, (00187) Roma – Italy, is the one processing your data.

2. The types of data that we process- Types of processed data

Your contact and account data. We will store and use the contact data that you provide us (for example: name, surname, address, telephone number, e-mail etc.) when you contact us to ask for information.

Information regarding the use of the Website and your activities on the Website. Your use of our website implies the processing of data on the *browser* of the device you are using and on your IP address (this is the number that identifies a specific device on the internet, and which is necessary in order for your device to communicate with websites.) We may analyze which site you have arrived from and which actions you are responsible for on our site.

3. Where we get your data- Data collection methods

Directly from you. For example, when you ask us for information. If you do not communicate your data to us, we cannot give you feedback on your requests.

4. Why and how long do we retain your data- Purpose and legal basis of data processing, period of conservation

In order to give you feedback about information and/or clarifications. We may use your e-mail or telephone number, as well as your name, in order to assist you whether you should need assistance following your information requests through the compilation of the designated form present on the Website.

The legal basis for this data processing is art. 6, comma I lett. b): to execute a request of the interested subject. The period of conservation of your data in relation to this data processing is equal to the time that is necessary in order to evade your request (provided that wherever other treatments are applicable the period of conservation is the one indicated in relation to such treatments which are present in the policy).

In order to prevent or control illegal conduct or to protect and assert rights. For example, we could use your data to prevent the violation of our intellectual property rights (for example counterfeiting our brands and/or our partner's brands), theft (such as credit card cloning and thefts that we believe may occur during a competition, festival or event) or other illegal acts according to the legal provisions applicable.

The legal basis of such processing is legitimate interest of the data processor.

The period of conservation of your data is equivalent to the time that is necessary in order to exercise our rights from the moment in which we become aware of the unlawful or of its potential committee.

Other purposes allowed by the law. In certain circumstances, we may use your data if there is a legitimate interest by Filmmaster Events S.r.l., in accordance with art. 6 par.1 (f) of GDPR, in compliance with your rights and limitations imposed by the law.

In relation to the purposes indicated above, the processing of personal data takes place through the use of manual, computerised and telematic instruments, with logic closely correlated to the purposes themselves, and in a way that guarantees the security and the privacy of the data in accordance with the law.

6. Cookie policy

Cookies are not used to profile the users, and no other tracking methods are used.

Session cookies (non persistent) are used in a strictly limited manner, which is necessary for secure and efficient browsing in the websites. The memorization of session cookies in terminals and browsers is under the user's control where at the end of the HTTP sessions information relative to cookies remain registered in the login services of the server, with conservation times not exceeding 7 days.

7. Where your data is processed – data transfer

The data will be treated and stored at Filmmaster Events S.r.l.'s offices and IT systems, and in the systems of its suppliers present on the Italian territory.

The personal data relative to you may also be preserved and disclosed to companies who provide services- specifically appointed controllers in accordance with art. 28 GDPR- who might be located in Countries outside the European Union (for example, the United States of America) and who, therefore, might not have the same laws and regulations on privacy and data protection of their own Country and/or whose level of protection of personal information might be considered inadequate for the standards of their Country.

Such data transfers are alternatively authorised according to:

- An adequacy decision of the third party country towards which the data is transferred, adopted by the European Commission in accordance with art. 45 of GDPR (for example: Privacy Shield); or
- Appropriate or opportune guarantees in accordance with articles 46, 47 and 49 of GRPR (such as standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission, binding corporate rules, guarantees of contractual nature provided by the owners involved, or such as derogations from the right of transfer applicable in specific situations), but also in accordance to the right of addressing the owner in order to obtain the contacts of the subjects to whom personal data has been communicated, from whom instructions regarding the means to obtain a copy of processed data or the location where the data has been made available.

8. Who we share your data with – recipients of personal data

Considering that, where requested by law, we may share your data with the following third parties (as external managers):

Our service providers We may share your data with third parties so that they will be able to provide services for us, yet in this case we will conclude an agreement according to art. 28 GDPR, aimed at protecting your data. These subjects will only obtain the data necessary for the fulfillment of their functions, and may only use them in order to perform these services for us or in order to comply with legal requirements. You may know the details of these data processors in accordance with art. 28 GDRPR by contacting us. If such providers should operate outside of the European Union, before communicating any of their personal data we will satisfy one of the conditions according to art. 45-47 of GDPR.

When it is considered necessary in order to comply with legal obligations or in order to protect third parties or ourselves judicially. Where it is allowed or imposed by law, we may also share the data requested by an authorised governing body or another subject or organisation so that we may exercise our own or third parties' rights, or in order to limit or avoid fraud (including credit card fraud or other frauds that we believe might happen during a lottery or the promotion of an event) and other illicit activities.

9. Minors

Our website is not intended for minors under 18 years of age, but is intended for an adult public. If you are a parent or tutor and you think that your child might have sent us data, you can contact us.

10. Security measures

We adopt the security measures required by law.

We adopt security measures in order to protect your data. The standard security measures what we use depend on the type of data that we process and meet the requirements prescribed by the law and EU government agency standards.

11. Your rights

You may contact Filmmaster Events S.r.l. in order to request access to your personal data, the adjustment, the cancellation or the limitation of the processing of the latter, in order to oppose yourself to the processing of this data and in order to request data portability; you may also revoke your consent at any time (this will not affect the legitimacy of the processing based on the consensus given before withdrawal).

When you exercise the right for access, you have the right to know if data processing is taking place, what the intent of the processing is, which categories of data are processed, who the recipients or categories of recipients are and who your data is communicated to (and, if they live in a third country, and on the basis of which guarantees), the period of conservation of you data (or the criteria to determine the period of conservation), if an authorised treatment is taking place (for example through profiling) and what the logic of such processing is, the origin of data (if they are not initially collected by us).

You have the right to file a complaint to the Data Protection Authority and to ask the owner information about data processors and subjects authorised to data processing by the owners at any time.

You may exercise your rights by contacting Filmmaster Events S.r.l.

In any case, you may modify or revoke your consent through the features of the site.

12. What do we do if we modify this policy

We may modify this privacy policy. We will notify you about such modifications as required by law. We will also published an updated version on our website. It will have a different date and version number from the one indicated below. Please consult the website periodically in order to see the updates.
